## Greenville Area Public Library Policy

## Section 3.1

## Computer Use

Computers in the Greenville Area Public Library are to be used for research and study. They are considered an extension of the Library's resources. The Library maintains the right to restrict access to users viewing offensive material as per the Internet Policy.

Patrons owing more than \$5.00 in fines will not be allowed to use the computers.

Computers may generally be used <u>ONE HOUR PER DAY</u> on a first come, first serve basis unless otherwise specified.

No more than two (2) people at a time may use a computer. No more than (2) computers may be used by family members at the same time.

Computers are available from the time the library opens until one-half (1/2) hour before closing.

If you encounter any problems with the equipment or programs, inform the staff immediately.

Use of the computer is free. Printed materials are subject to cost per page. All printed pages must be paid for.

Library staff cannot provide in-depth training, but may be able to offer searching suggestions or advice on some available resources.

Computer users under the age of 18 must have a signed parent/guardian consent form. Children under the age of twelve (12) must be accompanied by an adult.
